The Houston ISD School Board includes 9 trustees that are elected by people who live in each trustee's district. Trustees serve for a period of 4 years and have a variety of responsibilities including:

- Setting policies for the District
- Hiring the District Superintendent
- Setting the budget for the district
- Monitoring how schools perform

Anyone can attend a Board Meeting. Board Meetings occur the 2nd Thursday of each month, in the evenings. If you are unable to attend Board Meetings in person, you can watch meetings broadcast on local TV or live streamed on the district website at http://www.houstonisd.org/board.
